The Rosary will be said before Mass during the Month of May. May Crowning will be held on Mother's Day, during the entrance hymn.

More Eucharistic ministers are needed to bring Communion to shut-ins. It would also be nice to have a few stand-bys, in case the regular ones can't make it.
